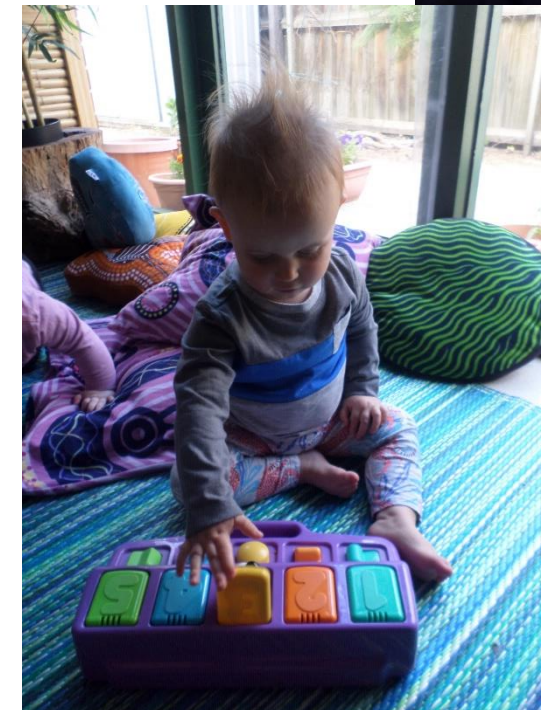


March Reflection 2
