*Children are showing much enthusiasm in participating and learning about the date of each day.*

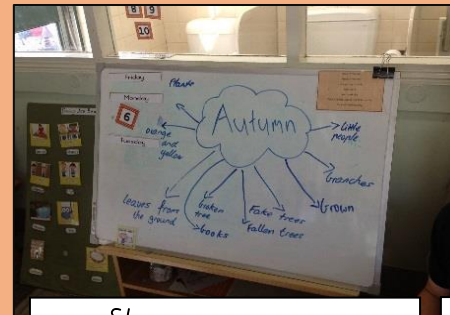
