We have started off the year with a new group of Joey children orientating and starting their full days in the second half of the month. The children have settled well into the room and are showing connection with their caregivers. The children have been exploring the different areas and corners. Some of the children are practicing their gross motor skills of sitting, crawling, standing momentarily in the room to some taking a couple of steps in the room. We slowly getting to know the individual routines of all the children, as well as the children getting to know the faces of the staff in the room, people coming and going as well as sleep pattern and feeling comfortable with staff feeding the children bottles. The children have enjoyed and showed confidence in climbing up and through the tunnel of the climbing frames. While other children have liked to explore the farm animals out under the cots either crawling over to them or sitting in the area for some time to play. These activities under the cots encourages the children to move about the room to encourage their curiosity to explore the environment. Through the daily interactions we can see the confidence the children have with their environment, the enjoyment of being with their friends and being happy for staff to comfort them during the day.
