The Joey children have been busy over the month achieving many different milestones from sitting, crawling and taking step in the room and outside to starting to show interest in feeding themselves at meal times. Throughout the program there are opportunities for the children to problem solve and gain independence, this maybe in the ball pool where the children learn how to crawl into and out of the ball pool. Some of the children will hold onto the shelf to step in and others will climb in by crawling in tipping the pool slightly as they manage their body to be able to sit inside the pool. Once inside the pool they like to explore the balls and socialise by smiling or touching the other children who are around them showing that they acknowledge one another and this forms the beginning of their social skills. Spending time outside gives the children time to learn about the community that they live in as well as seeing what is happening in the world around themselves. The children also learn to feel comfortable and secure in this environment and as opportunity arise we can extend on the time that we spend outside. The children who are not mobile are able to lie or sit on a mat with activities around them to be able to interact and slowly as they gain confidence crawl and walk. They are able to move around the yard to places they wish to see. During the month we welcome Sofia and her family to the room. We are looking forward to seeing all the children grow and develop through many milestones throughout the year.
