The Possum children have been busy this month playing in their environment. They have been using both the indoor and outdoor play spaces to initiate their paly experiences. Educators have observed the children beginning to interact with one another through games like row, row, row your boat, driving and sitting together in the combi van, sitting in the sand pit digging together and sitting in book corner and looking at books together. This is the beginning of their social interactions, the forming of friendships and group play.

The children are role-playing in home corner patting and rocking the dolls. To sitting down in book corner to look at books as they turn the pages, they will babble out loud like they are reading a book to themselves.

We are further developing and encouraging the children's independence skills through self-feeding, drinking from an open cup, to washing their hands before and after meals. The children are now able to recognise their own bedding at rest time and will now come in from outside and sit on their beds ready for rest time.
