

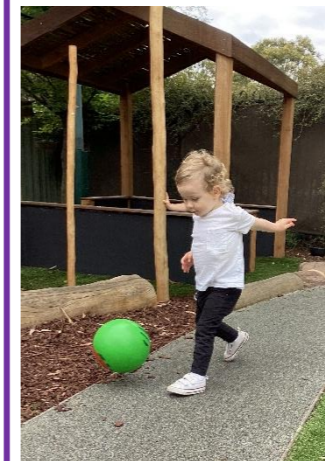
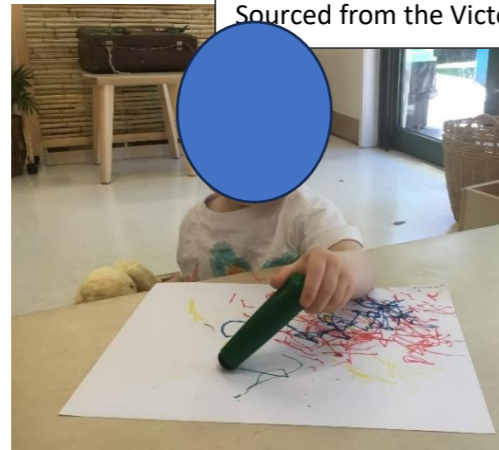
Possum Room January 2024 Reflection
