Waitangi Day was on the 6th of Feb. The possums contributed in making our own “Korowai” which is a traditional woven Māori cloak. The Korowai is worn as mantle of prestige and honour. The name Korowai is symbolic of leadership, and includes the obligation to care for the people and environment.

The children this year are very musical, boy they love to move. 😊 Group times are a very enjoyable time in our room, especially action songs and puppets. We begin our group times with our acknowledgement of Country, which always gets a little clap when we all say “Thank you”.

Sensory play has been a big hit this month, water play, play dough, as well as pasting and painting. It’s a great time for the children to explore new textures and we love mixing it up with nature. We walk around our yard taking from country, such as seed pods, twigs, leaves and bark all found in our yard.
