Reflection: We commence the term reflecting on what we have enjoyed participating in and recorded what we would like to learn this term through open discussions at group time and our drawings and descriptions. There were some common themes among the group such as learning how to draw objects of interest such as mermaids and monster trucks, make jewellery and music. Existing activities children thoroughly enjoyed last term and would like to continue to engage with are walks to the park, music, and games of space man. With the collated information shared we are excited to build on our current interest and engage with some new learning.



Making our own books- We learn concepts of literacy through making our very own picture story books, through this activity we openly express our creativity as we draw pictures and build on our prior knowledge with book orientation.



Outings to the park- With a growing interest with going for walks and a play to the park we continue to discuss and practice the importance in being safe and respectful to others and our spaces within our local community such as staying together, wearing our safety vest, taking our time, and acknowledging the land we on too.
